Please Do Not Call Out To Your Child In Class

Focus

As we create a terrific environment for your child to learn, one very important aspect is focus. We have found that if our students have one person in charge to focus on they will concentrate on the tasks at hand better.

Safety

Our #1 priority is the safety of your child and all of the other children in our classes. A call from the viewing area could cause a student to become distracted at a critical time while doing a skill. No one wants an injury due to a sudden distraction.

Listening And Following Directions

As you know, our younger students sometimes have difficulty listening and following directions in the best situation let alone when they are hearing the teacher and then hearing a parent.

Corrections

Yes, as you sit in the waiting area you may see your child bending their legs or not quite kicking hard enough for a new skill. The desire to "help" is strong. Resist that urge so that the teacher can maintain a good learning situation. Have confidence that we will make the necessary corrections and to give good instruction.

Loss of Control By Teacher

We believe that the best way to get your child to learn the fastest is to have one person in charge of a group of students. That teacher must be the main focus and the students must not be confused as to who to listen to. This is very important.

Confidence

Have confidence in your class teachers as they have trained extensively to improve the skills of your child and the others in the classes.

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
